**ORDINANCE NO. 21-06  
TOWN OF BRUCETON, TENNESSEE**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 207 OF THE BRUCETON MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE  
TO AUTHORIZED HOLIDAYS FOR TOWN PERSONNEL**

**SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BRUCETON that:**

Title 4, Chapter 2, Section 207, of the Bruceton Municipal Code be amended by deleting Section 207 in its entirety and substituting in lieu the of the following:

**4-207 Holidays authorized.** The following are the currently authorized holidays for full-time town employees:

All Federal Holidays plus the following:

- Good Friday
- Day after Thanksgiving
- Birthday or Personal Day


Holiday pay will not be paid if an employee has an unauthorized absence the day before or the day after the holiday. Police Officers that are required to work on a scheduled holiday will be paid for their normal shift, plus eight (8) hours holiday pay.

**SECTION II. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its final adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


